Davis Cup and Fed Cup venues announced

The ITF has announced that Prague and Buenos Aires will host two of the Davis Cup by BNP Paribas quarterfinals on 6-8 April, with Ostrava being the city of choice in the Fed Cup by BNP Paribas semifinal between Czech Republic and Italy on 21-22 April. The Russian Tennis Federation has been granted an extension until 24 February to confirm the venue for Russia's semifinal against Serbia.

The Czech Davis Cup team will make a rare appearance at the O2 Arena in the country's capital city for the highly anticipated clash against 2010 champions Serbia. It will be the first time that a Davis Cup tie has been played in Prague since the World Group play-offs in 2007, when the Czech duo of Tomas Berdych and Radek Stepanek overcame Switzerland, who had the world No. 1 at the time, Roger Federer, among their ranks.

They will be hoping the city proves similarly successful against a Serbian team that could be led by the current No. 1, Novak Djokovic. Argentina, meanwhile, will play host to Croatia at Parque Roca in Buenos Aires in a tie to be played on outdoor clay. The last time the South Americans lost a home tie on clay was against Slovak Republic in 1998.

The venue for one of the 2012 Fed Cup by BNP Paribas semifinals has also been announced. Czech Republic, who are playing at home for the first time since winning Fed Cup last November, have chosen the CEZ Arena in Ostrava for their last four meeting with Italy.

Tarango among first-time winners in San Diego

The ITF Seniors World Individual Championships drew to a close at La Jolla Beach and Tennis Club in San Diego, USA, on Sunday after a successful week in which almost 750 players from 46 countries competed for 25 titles in singles, doubles and mixed doubles.

In contrast to the World Team Championships the previous week, when the host nation failed to match its usual dominance and won just one of the 10 cups on offer, American players claimed a host of individual titles in both singles and doubles. Most of those were first-time winners, including Jeff Tarango in the men's 40s, Mark Vines in the men's 55s, Jennifer Dawson in the women's 45s and Rosalyn Nideffer in the women's 50s.

Jeff Greenwald won the men's 45s to claim his second world title and his first since 2001, and Diane Barker successfully defended her women's 55 crown to win her fifth world individual singles title. Val Wilder in the men's 50s added a fourth singles title to his growing collection and also collected a fourth doubles title with his defeated final opponent Mike Fedderly. For Fedderly, it was a ninth world doubles title.

The other men's singles title went to Spain's Roberto Menendez, who defeated 2009 world champion Benjamin Budziak (POL) in the 35 age category. Spain also claimed the women's 35s as 2008 world champion Noelia Perez beat Kelly Pace Wilson (USA) to win her second title. The women's 40 crown went to another first-time winner, Australian Jurate Hardy.

Qualifiers book their place at BNP Paribas World Team Cup

Sri Lanka and Thailand secured their places in the men's World Group 2 and women's World Group events for May's BNP Paribas World Team Cup in Seoul, Korea, after winning the first of four regional qualification events in New Delhi, India, on Sunday.

Top seeds Sri Lanka got off to a solid start in the men's event, Dissanayake Gamini and Upali Rajakurna both securing 64 61 victories in their singles rubbers against Malaysia and then teaming up in the doubles to wrap up a 3-0 victory in the first of Sri Lanka's two round-robin ties.

After both teams had beaten India 3-0, Sri Lanka and Malaysia went head-to-head again in Sunday's final play-off tie, Gamini and Rajakaruna again emulating each other with 62 61 wins over King Hong Kee and Abu Samah Borhan respectively to wrap up overall victory.

In the women's event, Thailand and Australia both beat Sri Lanka in the round-robin phase of the competition without dropping a game in any of their singles or doubles rubbers. Thailand's Chusri Inthanin had beaten Luba Josevksi 60 60 as Thailand beat Australia 3-0 in their round-robin tie, but when they met again in the final play-off Inthanin met more resistance before prevailing 64 62. But former world No. 6 Sakhorn Khanthast went on to seal another comfortable victory for Thailand after easing past Janet Manns 60 60.

2012 Approved Balls & Surfaces published

The ITF Technical Department has published its "ITF Approved Tennis Balls, Classified Surfaces & Recognised Courts 2012 – a guide to products and test methods".

Compiled by the ITF Technical Centre, this annual booklet lists all balls that are approved for tournament play under the Rules of Tennis, and over 200 surfaces that have obtained ITF Classification for court pace. This comprehensive booklet provides information on the testing procedures for ball approval and surface classification as well as contact details for all suppliers. All ITF National Associations will be receiving copies of this booklet by mail within the next few weeks. Randy Snow elected into ITHF

Randy Snow has been posthumously elected into the International Tennis Hall of Fame for 2012. The three-time Paralympic medallist was an influential leader in the development of Wheelchair Tennis and a tireless advocate for improving the quality of life for people with disabilities. He is the second wheelchair tennis player to be elected into the ITHF after Brad Parks. Snow died in November 2009 in El Salvador while volunteering at a wheelchair tennis camp.

The Class of 2012 induction ceremony will take place on 14 July at the International Tennis Hall of Fame and Museum in Newport, Rhode Island, USA.
